Nineveh, the capital of the Assyrian



Nineveh is mentioned much by the Bible prophets, Isaiah, Micah and also Nahum, whose description of chariots rushing through the wide streets of Nineveh. makes the city sound like congested **London.** Apparently, Assyria was more warlike, living in more mountainous areas and Babylon more cultured. though equally efficient in war: vet both fell. Though the cities and empires had aspects of uniqueness making them different from each other, they were alike in at least one major way: pride. The Bible is full of living examples of victories or defeats in temptation, and you may choose which team you' ll be on.



Years ago, I drove 20 miles south on a motorway to take a very nice girl to a restaurant. However, I was so taken up with her presence in the car that, after eating, I didn't realise that I continued driving south on that motorway instead of returning north! Various signs for strange cities seemed to puzzle me, but I carried on. When I began seeing road signs for the State Capitol, I knew I had made a big mistake!

The Bible says that God is "the true and faithful witness." Yet people can be so taken up with their love of something that they either don't see or don't want to see the road signs of God.

On another occasion, but before God saved me, I was sitting in a parked car doing something I shouldn't, when suddenly over the car's radio came the voice of a preacher...HOW, I do not know.
