If you get a Bible and read the chapters in Revelation which this article refers to. I believe God will speak to you. There we read of rejoicing and of torment, both of which exceed our present earthly powers of comprehension—but that shouldn't shock us. for even in this present world, many things appear to pass over the heads of the masses. Mention is made in Revelation chapters 13,14,15,16,19 & 20 of what is called **"the** mark of the beast." That "mark," as well as other aspects of "end-time events" has been sensationalized in movies. It is easy for such films to desensitize people regarding any fear or any need to prepare for that time, or even for death. People become further hardened by severe acts of violence and sex seen in films and heard in modern music. Daily news confirms the callous wreckage.

Let's get back to Rev. 14, which I would encourage you to read for yourself. In Rev.14 and also in 16, 17, & 18, mention is likewise made of "Babylon, the great." That city is the target of the wrath of God

The Bible *does* have very significant things to say to help a person know just how God feels about how we *appear*, as well as what we *are* in our heart. One such Bible selection is found in chapter 16 of the Old Testament prophet, Ezekiel. Just as we have referred to "Babylon" in the front page article, so in this one we find Ezekiel beginning with reference to "Jerusalem." However, though there were actual cities by these names, yet what God says here to the inhabitants of Jerusalem, He says to you and me today—believe me.

I wish I had space to print the entire chapter here for you. It is dramatic, very blunt and graphic as it relates, for example, to childbirth, puberty, and actual love, and eminently succeeds in fastening to OUR minds the mind of GOD in this matter which is so obviously a priority to Him. In the details of this chapter, regarding iewellerv for example, we know that God Himself slowly revealed His perfect will and plan for us throughout the thousands of years of Bible history. I mean that what is often *exter*nal in the Old Testament, God clearly reveals to have been a mere illustration of the greater *internal* truth revealed in the New Testament. It is true, that "God looks on the heart," yet what we wear, what we do and say, what we read and where we go are all indicators of what we are in our hearts.

Once again, space does not allow for gleaning the many lessons from this chapter. **Here's one lesson:** The beauty with which God Himself adorned this once-abandoned, newborn baby—now grown to maturity—this

mature female now believes is natural. in-built beauty! This was not the end of the self-deception, for falsely believing that she was a self-made beauty queen, she then proceeded to prostitute herself with those of the surrounding pagan nations. This whole narrative is an excellent, though tragic, picture of what the human family has done and is doing today. Today's world and today's newspapers provide daily testimony of the grossest prostitution of what the human race is intended by God to be. This both breaks the heart of God and infuriates the love of God. which has spared nothing to provide for our greatest peace and holiness, and thereby our greatest satisfaction. This God-given beauty and satisfaction gives birth to God-inspired creativity and productivity. Sterile, fruitless "religion" is a perversion of this beauty.

What God wanted to display in holiness from within mankind through the people of Israel in the Old Testament, He wanted *ultimately* to do (as even the O. T. clearly states) through "the Church," which is made up of people from all nations under heaven. "The Brotherhood of Man" certainly includes that all of us are born with a sin problem. Original man (Adam and Eve) failed, as did the Jews, and as has the Church. An alternative "religion" is not the answer, whether it be Scientology or others.

The casualties of "ugliness" litter the streets worse than McDonald's wrappers, though their value is incomparable. Ezekiel 16:14 says that the beauty that God put upon His people made them famous. This is a true fame which God has fitted to bless all nations. God said that the beauty of His people was perfect, and that this perfection of beauty was due to His glory, magnificence, splendour and majesty. Yet, it was because of the prostitution of this God-implanted beauty that the prophet Jeremiah writes of the ridicule of the surrounding nations at the loss of this beauty: "All who pass by clap their hands at you; They hiss and shake their heads at the daughter of Jerusalem: "Is this the city that is called 'The perfection of *beauty*, The joy of the whole earth?" All your enemies have opened their mouth against you; They hiss and gnash their teeth. They say, "We have swallowed her up! Surely this

it, we have seen it!" (Lamentations 2:15,16). Another way to show the perfection of uginess (in contrast to the perfection of beauty) is to be willing to rejoice that we would all go to Hell together. There are no handsome hulks nor beauty queens in Hell, for Hell is the Eternal and International Capitol of Uginess. In contrast, God wants to make all people beautiful within, to go to the beautiful city He has prepared. God makes clear His willingness to restore even self-made ugly people into beautiful people again, as we see here in Ezekiel 14 and also in Jeremiah 18, where God is seen remaking the Potter's spoiled vessel. He's the same today!

what about Divine love which God puts within weak, "forgiven and changed" humans? **Does it fail?** Yes, it can...but not in the same way the earthly things fail and fade away. Jesus told Peter that He had prayed for him, that his faith would not fail...but Peter's faith *DID* fail. Yes, but Jesus' words meant "to fail utterly," and Peter's faith *WAS* restored! Love never fails!

One newspaper had photos of well-knowns (including Mr. Blair), showing them 10 years ago compared to now. Steroids-defaced Stallone admitted his unsightly appearance, but said he was Brad Pitt on the inside! I am not a film fan, yet Stallone's words capture the truth St. Paul said, that "though our outward man is perishing, yet our inward man is being renewed day by day!" (2 Cor. 4:16). Paul's words were strictly spiritual, and the world does not have this to offer, despite the recent sell-out of beauty cream. Film and sport stars and such others will fade into eternal darkness, along with its other fearful features, "but the path of the just is as a shining light that shines more and more unto the perfect day!" (Prov. 4:18). Divine love never fails!

Time and time again, in reference to Pentecost, and the coming of the Holy Spirit, Christ and His disciples said that receiving this blessing will also make us God's witnesses to others, so that they, too, may get right with Him. So, this all brings to our personal attention a great privilege, as well as a grave responsibility...but what love this shows!!



It was as the agony of **a caring surgeon's knife** that caused St. Peter to squirm, for Jesus asked him <u>three times</u>, "*Do you love Me?*" Peter had denied Christ <u>three times</u>, and his spiritual recovery travelled over the same road.

"The Prodigal Son" likewise travelled familiar roads to make his way back to his father's house to repent and throw himself on his father's mercy. Getting to God, or getting *back* to God can include unpleasant journeying which many prefer to avoid, not knowing that this very unpleasantness is the only road to the blessedness.

That Jesus asked of Peter's love does not imply (as some blasphemously suggest) that Jesus and His disciples were homosexuals anymore than the love to Christ from the "sinful woman" meant that Jesus had an affair or got married later and had a family.

On 27 May we celebrated "Pentecost," also called "Whitsunday," which commemorates the day when the Holy Spirit came in His fullness into Christ's waiting and ready disciples. As my girl friend became my fiancé and then my wife, so the Holy Spirit convicts then also converts the open-hearted, receptive sinner, but then will furthermore cleanse and fill that "believer" in a way surpassing initial conversion. It is the same Person being "received," yet in a different capacity. Many things happen in these incidents, but certainly sin is "thrown out," and love and likeness to God is brought in. This happens through Christ's work on the Cross, and through the applying of this "provided and healing medicine" of the blood of Christ by "the Doctor's Assistant:" the Holy Spirit!

"The Love Chapter" of the Bible (1 Cor.13) has some awesome things to tell us about the greatest kind of love. You will be rewarded by reading it carefully, and letting it "soak in." Though verse 8 says that many things *shall cease*, it says that "Divine Love never fails?" God's love to man is shown in that even while we were all actively "sinners," of one sort or another, yet God "so loved the world that He gave" Jesus, and that notwithstanding our rebellious condition, "Christ died for us." Divine love, even from God's side, "never fails." But
