gives "content" or "substance" to the idea of holiness. Jesus puts a "handle" on the idea of holiness and its related features such as love, compassion and truth. He makes God's character understandable. Through Jesus, the holiness of God is no longer "abstract." This is why the very highest standard of moral character to which we can aspire comes clearly to our minds by the word "Christ-like." Jesus makes God's Way, as well as God's Character, plain.

For this reason, we can understand why God places all authority in Christ, just as the Bible repeatedly declares. Last month we commemorated Jesus' birth. A well-known "fore-telling" of the birth of God's ONLY promised Messiah is God's word through the prophet, Isaiah. It says, "For unto us a Child is born, unto us a Son is given; and the government will be upon His shoulder. And His name will be called Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. Of the increase of His government and peace There will be no end, upon the throne of David and over His kingdom, to order it and establish it with judgment and justice from that time forward, even forever. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will perform this" (9:6,7). "Zeal" here, is the same passionate word translated elsewhere, "jealous." The earlier verses of Isaiah 9 reveal enemies, but the word, "For," means that God is doing something about those enemies! When referring to God, the word translated "zeal" or "jealous" apparently always refers to His anger against that which destroys those whom He loves, and therefore, a love-inspired anger!

The current global crisis, which involves economy, industry and military is largely the strategy of those who have been seeking one-world government for generations. Way back in 1931 in The "a stable economy!" (1 Cor. 3:11).

Trend of International Affairs Since the War. Arnold J. Toynbee wrote: "We are at present working discreetly with all our might to wrest this mysterious force called how He acts and what He says, for Jesus 1 sovereignty out of the clutches of the local nation states of the world. All the time we are denying with our lips what we are doing with our hands." This tells us at least two things: 1) Today's quicklyemerging one-world government has been planned for generations, 2) The planners of this one-world government, are seen, by Toynbee's example, to be people of the most sinister deceit. These facts have great relevance to the present world situation, and how it effects us all as individuals. I see that the atheist bus advert campaign has Toynbee's granddaughter, Polly, as a co-aid with Dawkins. I also see more deceit!

Standing in the clearest contrast to these evil, one-world planners is the one-world government of God! But look at the character difference of the leadership! When I look at the perfect love of God as seen in Jesus Christ, how can I complain or argue against such administration? The present one-world system is a counterfeit and competitor to God's. Multi-sided Madness put Caesar, Religion and Barabbas above Christ. That same scene is here today.

At Christmas, we remembered that Jesus was born in a **stable.** The One born in that **stable** *later* turned a storm-tossed sea into a **stable** one (Mark 4:39). He is the *only* Source of "a stable economy" or "system" today. No, we won't have a new "Garden of Eden" until Christ returns. Anyway, to enter THAT glorious place we must have a current "passport"...and no *fake* passport can fool God! God's "passport" requirements are so clear and simple that a child may apply! Oh, that people were as eager and determined to enter Heaven as many have been for so long to enter Britain! Of Jesus, God said, "This is My beloved Son in whom I am well pleased. Hear Him!" (Matt. 17:5; 3:17; Acts 3:22; 2 Pet. 1:17; Isa. 42:1). HE is God's only provided Foundation for



God encouraged and instructed **Joshua.** whom He had chosen as leader after Moses had died. God told the people that they needed to be holy and to listen, saying "for you have not travelled this way before!" There are many Bible sections that give blessing and guidance regarding this very important matter. One of these is chapter four from the book of Proverbs. There we see "wisdom" as an actual person, trying to reason with us all. God is "personified" as "wisdom;" willing to share "wisdom" with every listening ear, tender heart and receptive mind! Tender and the only one in the sight of my mother, 4 He also taught me, and said to me: "Let your heart retain my words; Keep my commands, and live. 5 Get wisdom! Get understanding! Do not forget, nor turn away from the words of 1 or the left; Remove your foot from evil.

To his shock and embarrassment, he couldn't remember the order to have the men turn, and they were heading directly for the large body of water! Another soldier whispered the command to him...

just in time to avert disaster!

Proverbs 4 verse 26 (on the page to the left) says "Ponder the path of your feet." But the next verse says "Don't turn!" This is not a contradiction, for there is a time to turn, and there is a time to keep going straight ahead! From the pen of the prophet, Ezekiel, God gives us examples of both. We see the same truth in chapter 18 and in chapter 33. Briefly put, God says that if He tells a sinner "You are in big trouble," and he thinks on his way and changes, then none of his sin will be remembered against him. Such a person will be on good terms with God. Ezekiel also says that if God speaks approvingly to a person who is walking with Him, and then that person trusts in himself and his past blessing from God, and begins sinning rather than continuing to obey God, then none of that person's earlier right-ness will be remembered by God. In other words, God will "delete" the record of good or bad, depending on the action of the person. Read it for yourself. Such truth as this brings hope to the 'worst," and proper caution to the Both of those people "best." "pondered" or *considered* their path. Both changed. One was very wise. The other was so very, very foolish.

One of the greatest Bible examples of a person considering his sin, and then turning from it, is clearly painted in Psalm 51. This Psalm contains the words of King David, who wholeheartedly turned from his sin after being confronted by God's courageous prophet, Nathan in 2 Samuel 12:7. You had better thank God when He sticks His finger in your face and says "YOU are the man!" Sometimes God will use another person, or sometimes God will use a circumstance, or just the wonderful

voice of His own holy Spirit.

Not everybody listens, however. Even though Governor Felix "trembled" at God's truth coming from St. Paul, he cooled it off, tried to postpone, and then even hoped that St. Paul would offer him money to release him from imprisonment (Acts 24: 25, 26). You can't bribe God, nor a Nathan, nor a St. Paul! But you can obey the voice and calling of God, and turn. I noticed near the end of Psalm 51, David says that when he gets right with God, then he will help others to get right with God, too! What about you? Jesus told of a man (Luke 16) who wished to turn his own brothers away from sin's path and sin's end...but it was too late, for that man was already in hell himself!

Finally, in **Revelation 3**, Jesus reasons with a group of "religious professors" who really didn't know who they were. They thought they were "ok" spiritually, whereas God's estimate was that they were in BIG trouble, and would drop into Hell. Jesus lovingly tells them the way out. The choice was theirs then, and the choice is ours today. Jesus has His hands out now! Turn to the "right," and keep going straight!

MORE WISDOM: No one is left out, if they will take their place God's Way! "But God has given you a place in Jesus Christ, through whom God has given us godly wisdom, forgiveness and new life, and inward holiness, and full deliverance from the slavery of sin" (1 Cor. 1:30). The apostle, James [chapter 4], describes both the wisdom FROM God, and the "wisdom" that DOESN'T come from God. James says that the difference is seen in our conduct. It shows! Wisdom from God "is first holy!" New Year's Resolutions for a life pleasing to God, and to the help and eternal salvation of our fellow man, CAN be a reality with God's help. BE WISE!

PLEASURE'S PATTERN! We need not replace "gloomy predictions of a horrible year," with "Go On, Enjoy Yourself!" Let atheist scientists examine theories by their strongest, not weakest arguments. Regarding both "Christianity," and "Pleasure-seeking," we see Jesus as the Standard for comparison. HE is Our Great "Argument!" The Bible states: "For even Christ did not please Himself" (Rom. 15:3). Christ chose to do the Father's will and finish it! "Redeeming-love" seeks to live for God and others, not for self! Follow the Pattern!
