The shepherd searched until he found the one lost sheep out of 100. The woman turned her house upside down to find the one lost coin of the 10. But no one went out to find the one lost lad of two sons. Do we *really* love God while we just leave people to die in their sins and drop into Hell without trying to reach them?

The father of that lost lad didn't go physically to bring his son back home. Yet the father *did* follow his son *another way!* It was the remembrance of his father's love and care for him that awoke this lost young man to the sensibleness of returning home in humble confession and submission to his loving father...and he did it!

"Lift up a standard for the people." Isaiah 62:10

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This article is not to "humour," nor to declare that "swine flu" is a God-sent **judgment.** However, "swine flu" freshly reminds us of the worst pandemic lurking. Apparently, every UK household is to receive an NHS leaflet regarding swine flu. We got one. I could wish people were as much concerned about the worse "pandemic" of which I am now writing.

Various non-vegetarians will not eat "swine" meat. Some ancient Jews would not even say the name of the animal, but simply refer to "that thing!" Sadly, in some radical books of Muslims and Jews, even other humans (other than themselves!) are referred to in horrific terms! But some "not religious" people likewise speak terribly of others without just cause. Mixing pigs and people, or monkeys and men is equally an affront to God and man.

In "the Law of Moses," God forbad eating "unclean animals," in contrast to "clean animals." Long before, Noah was told by God to take two of the "unclean," yet seven of the

"clean" onto the Ark. (Gen.7:2). But among the "unclean animals." swine seem to have won first place for disgust.

Prompting dread, disgust and even quarantine, was the formerly-incurable disease: leprosy, also known as Hansen's disease. It seems that ancient Jews had practically equal abhorrence for lepers and pigs. While God had given a brieflyworded ban on eating pigs, He went at length regarding the various forms and stages of leprosy, and what to do with those who contracted it. People who had the disease were tested and quarantined, and if confirmed, were kept isolated from the general public. Houses irreparably plagued with leprosy were tore down. The "plague" of leprosy sent a message so clear and so drastic that it was long seen as a "Bible type" illustrating "the plague of sin" itself.

It became "normal" for some people

to interact with foreigners only if and when necessary. And to have to associate with certain others was almost a torture and disgrace! It is rare for people to get the full picture of God's love for all people, even in Old Testament times. Shortly after Moses' death, the first city conquered under the new leader, Joshua, was Jericho. From that city, God saved a foreigner-prostitute and her entire family, plus chose that

Like the front page article, this one makes reference to a threat to human life, while using the subject to make valid and extremely important spiri**tual application.** Early April found Italy traumatised by an earthquake. Southern Italv has been hit with earthquakes for centuries, including Europe's worse in 1908. China now relives the horror of the quake a year ago that killed nearly 90,000! People try to answer questions regarding the matter, like what causes them, where are the danger zones and can they be predicted. I saw internet videos of "strange lights" in the sky just prior to China's devastating earthquake last year.

In speaking of "the signs of the times" leading up to His Second Coming, Jesus listed increase of earthquake activity. Many people know this. The last book of the Bible, "Revelation," makes repeated reference to earthquakes, the last of which is as follows: "and there was a great earthquake, such as was not since men were upon the earth, so mighty an earthquake, and so great" (16:18). Some imply that these "earthquake judgments" will not be literal earthquakes, but worldwide upheaval or chaos like the world has never seen before. Frankly, anyone is out of their mind who would enjoy such global turbulence, or say, "See, there isn't any *real* earthquake!" I remember a strict Jew once telling me that Jesus was wrong about Jerusalem being destroyed by the Romans, because Jesus said "not one stone would be left on top of another." Listen! Jesus' words indicated horrific destruction, and He was "spot on." If you had been there, I can just imagine you looking around in shock and amazement and gasping out, "There's not one stone **left on another!**" Dear friend, trouble *IS* coming, and we had better get ready now, and stay ready.

Actually, in the Bible, God refers to other earthquakes, in the Old Testament as well as the New, that can help us in life now and troubles that are yet to come.

Moses faced a scarv scene like the one described in Revelation, though he was at the mountain where he got the 10 Commandments from God. Hebrews 12:21 says "And so terrifying was the sight that Moses said, 'I am exceedingly fearful and trembling.' "Friend, I play no psychological games with you. James 2:19 informs us that even demons have enough sense to tremble, for though they "believe in God," yet they are workers for God's "competitor," Satan! "Believing in God" or not, those who do not submit to God's authority are working for His competitor, just like the demons. Heb. 12:25-29 says, "See that you do not refuse Him who speaks. For if they did not escape who refused Him who spoke on earth, much more shall we not escape if we turn away from Him who speaks from heaven, whose voice then shook the earth; but now He has promised, saying, "Yet once more I shake not only the earth, but also heaven." Now this, "Yet once more." indicates the removal of those things that are being shaken, as of things that are made, that the things which cannot be shaken may remain. Therefore, since we are receiving a kingdom which cannot be shaken, let us have grace, by which we may serve God acceptably with reverence and godly fear. For our God is a consuming fire.

The word, "Pentecostal," (above) is not referring to "Pentecostal churches." Such groups get their "label" from the first "Pentecost," recorded in the Bible (Acts 2). Yet, professing Christians should know that even in the spiritual realm "not everything that glitters is gold!" This includes various outward characteristics that resemble the genuine, but are merely superficial religious cosmetics. Elijah, the prophet, is called The Prophet of Fire, being known for that dramatic contest on Mt. Carmel wherein "the God that answers by fire" was the true God. Yet, not long after when he was hiding from the Oueen's death squad. God tried to speak to him (1 Kings 19). God approached His man by the customary ways that are "symbols" of God's Spirit: fire and wind. God even used an earthquake. but as with the fire and wind. the record says, "but the Lord was not in the earthquake!" Last of all, God used the manner He purposely wanted to use at that time, and "His man" could tell the difference. It was "a still small voice!" Neither *quietness* nor *noise* alone are proof of God's presence with us, and we had better be able to tell the difference!

The "Earthquake!" article on the left mentions Moses' "I exceedingly fear and quake (tremble)." He wasn't alone. I wish there were more. "God's mouthpiece," the prophet Amos, is the one through whom God called to us all, saying: "and because I will do this unto you, prepare to

meet your God!" (4:12). The very first verse of the book of Amos tells the time-period of his ministry: "in the days of King Uzziah...two vears before the earthquake."

The prophet, Zechariah, foretold the birthplace of the Messiah, His Triumphant Entry into Jerusalem, that He would be sold for 30 pieces of silver and that He would be pierced (on the Cross). But Zechariah also foretold the fear that would grip the people of his own day, saying: "and you shall flee as you fled from before the earthquake in the days of Uzziah king of Judah" (14:5). The people had vivid enough recollection of it that such a comparison spoke directly to their

knowledge and experience.

But there was a greater earthquake in King Uzziah's day than the one referred to by Amos and Zechariah. It happened "in the year King Uzziah died," and is told by Isaiah the prophet. That earthquake was the one that happened *inside* Isaiah himself, and trust me, it measured high on God's Richter Scale! Read it in Isaiah 6. In that chapter, we have the revealing to Isaiah of God's holiness and Isaiah's *UNholiness!* God is seen making provision for Isaiah's cleansing of heart and tongue, after which Isaiah's ears were finally open to hear God's call to reach out faithfully to the rest of the people in behalf of God's holy love for mankind. Friend, what I am describing here for vou is exactly what happened in Acts 2 on the first Day of Pentecost: holiness. cleansing from sin and sending out to reach others with God's message. I am afraid that many who profess to know God live day after day with unclean hearts and mouths and ears that cannot hear. To us all Christ says what He said to each of the 7 churches in Revelation 2 and 3: "He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says unto the churches.'

EARTHOUAKE FAULTLINE: An earthquake at Christ's crucifixion (Matt.27:54) and later resurrection (Matt. 28:2) brought different Roman soldier responses. The *1st* worshipped! The 2nd group lied. Jesus lifts any true seeker to true peace with God, for He IS who He claimed and showed Himself to be. A "fault line" is a long crack in the earth's surface. Earthquakes usually occur on them. Adam's Fall instantly created a Fault. That fault is called sin. Thankfully, God can send an earthquake your way to get you out of the sin business and ready to meet Him, and help others to do so, as well. Man is "cracked," both superficially *and* deep in his heart. Earthquakes are frightening, but, this one alone will lift us to the place of Safety!
