A true story of craftiness from the Old Testament will hopefully illustrate the point of this article. It comes from the life of King David, and centres around his son. Absalom, who craftily had his step-brother, Amnon, killed. Amnon, two years before, had used craftiness to rape Absalom's sister, Tamar (2 Sam.13). This story could spoil "the spirit of Christmas," if I didn't know the point it illustrates! The whole string of sad events resulted from David's own sin of adultery, and the murder and cover-up that followed. ("Be sure your sin will find you out." Num. 32:23).

The Good News is that God made a Way to "save" murderers, adulterers and everyone else like you and me! This is what Christmas is really all about. Let me digress from King David and explain. Christ's birth was a sort of "Mars landing" in God's rescuing of mankind...in Person!

"The Mighty God... Everlasting Father... Prince of Peace" (Isa. 9:6) the long-promised Messiah-Saviour of God— was to be born in Bethlehem (Micah 5:2 & Matt. 2:5). This world was "a foreign planet" to God, who is absolutely holy. (Jn 1:10). Yet, into our Mars-like "World at War" came this Prince of Peace! Of course, Satan always has crafty counterfeits to oppose God's Plan (as in Dan. 8:25).

God invaded "OUR" land (that HE made!), not "to bring democracy," but to bring salvation from all sin, and the real and true freedom that comes with it.

Our world is not the way it was at Creation. Man started polluting the environment with sin, which has ever been the internationally-peerless pollutant. It causes trouble in homes and schools, among the "religious" and the "nonreligious," and causes blood on streets. It pollutes the minds and hearts of society by multiple means, starts wars...the list is endless. Man himself is so polluted that he generally appears to have no inclination to get to the root of the matter...but God did! Yes, this is what **Christmas** is all about.

followed it? Remember, Absalom killed Amnon. but then Absalom ran away to his grandpa; staying in exile for three years. After grieving Amnon's death, David craved to be reunited with Absalom. David's general, Joab, saw this desire and hatched a crafty plan to bring Absalom back. The Bible account shows us that *it* may have been better for everyone around if Absalom had stayed away. God knows.

General Joab got "a wise woman," and gave her the central part in his crafty plan to get the king's son back. See this in 2 Sam. 14. Joab invented a story for the woman, who was then to tell it to David. This false story was to appear to concern two sons of this widowed woman: one killing the other, then other members of the extended family wanting to kill the murdering son. This would leave the woman completely alone. When David replied that he would protect her son, she used this to expose the king's inconsistency of not allowing his *own* son to return.

This "wise woman" made an awesome point saying, "God devises means that the expelled outcast may not be kept outcast from Him" (2 Sam. 14:14). What truth is in those words! Due to their own sin, "our original parents," Adam and Eve, were the first ones expelled by God. As a result, the entire human family became outcast from God who is holy. But this lady revealed an amazing truth: "God has devised means to bring back the outcast!" This Plan of God was made "before the foundation of the world" (1 Pet. 1:20), but "activated" at Christ's birth. "Christmas" is God's devised means for bringing back the outcast. One song says: "When I could not come to where He was, He came to me!"

In the original language, the words "devises means" literally means "thinks thoughts." God thinks about you and me. The Bible also says "God who spoke...has spoken!" (Heb. 1:1, 2). God speaks, thinks and much more... He acts! The birth, life, ministry, death, resurrection and ascension of Christ is God's unique, superlative, unprecedented and unparalleled ACTION! "God has devised means!"

God had said through His prophet, Jeremiah, "For I know the thoughts that I

think toward you, says the LORD, thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a *future and a hope*" (29:11). In Jeremiah's time, God's people had two moral attitudes because of the Babylonian army that surrounded them: 1) Useless confidence, then 2) Despair! They had not listened to God nor His prophets, and paid dearly for it. We all should take that lesson seriously for this world is now under siege. Trust me.

Jesus Himself said "the one who comes to Me I will by no means cast out" (Jn.6:37). God devises means! Eliza Hewitt's great song, My Faith Has Found A Resting Place says: "Enough for me that Jesus died. This ends my fear and doubt: A sinful soul I come to Him, He'll never cast me out." Yes! "God devises means that the expelled outcast may not be kept outcast from Him" Notice—"may not." You have a choice in the matter. Yes, we *may* be cast out forever, but this need not happen!

Under Moses. God had instituted what were called "cities of refuge," where anyone who accidentally killed another person could go for safety. Such a person was required to remain there "until the death of the high priest" (Num. 35:25). Some people took the risk, left early, and were found and killed by vengeful family members. A similar thing happened under David's son King Solomon. (1 Kings 2:36-46). Sin tricks people into feeling invincible; maybe invisible! ("No consequences. No one sees me!") Wrong!

Jesus Christ, our Great High Priest, has an unending Priesthood! (Heb. 7). Though guilty, we may run to Him, our "city of refuge." Yet, we must remain in Him (Jn. 15), or suffer spiritual decay, and in eternity-worse. This need not be. Christmas shouts to us all: "God devises means!" God "thinks thoughts," as in Jer. 29:11 above. Our part is given in 29:13-"And you will seek Me and find Me, when you search for Me with all your heart." God thinks thoughts and devises means. We must think and act, too! The Prodigal Son (Lk. 15: 17,18) thought and acted and his days as an outcast were over! The love of the Prodigal's father was enough to encourage his son to return. The Prodigal was desperate. He had had enough. If you have, too, there's a celebration waiting for you. (Lk. 15:22-24). Crafty Christmas!!

A great 18th century English preacher told a large outdoor crowd that the love of God is so great, and

Jesus loves people so much that he would save even the Devil's castaways! Apparently, a refined Christian lady thought his language was a bit extreme or improper. However, the preacher's words had found their target in the hearts of some women of the streets. They sent a message to the preacher informing him that his words brought salvation and hope...even to them. as low as they were. Their lives... broken in body, soul and spirit... had been rescued by the God of all grace. Though they had been "the Devil's castaways," Jesus took them in!

Jesus said that "many will come from the east and west" (Matt. 8:11) being fully accepted by God into fellowship with Him. while those who know the truth but don't obey it are shut out forever. The end depends on our actual response to God's truth. People and groups may have selfish prejudices with which God Himself is not in agreement, yet these people would close off and cut off other people that God receives with open arms!

Christ's "east and west" could refer to geography-that God will receive anyone, world-wide who truly repents of sin, and will completely make them "a new creation in Christ!" (2 Cor. 5:17). "East and west" could also refer to circumstanceswhether "down and outers," or "up and outers," or anything in between! God will save people from the gutter-most "to the uttermost!" (Heb. 7:25). As the angel said to Jesus' parents: "You shall call His name

Jesus, for He shall save His people from their sins!" (Matt. 1:21). New Life and true hope is a "Christmas Gift" that no one should CAST AWAY. (Jn. 1:12,13).



Christmas celebrates the birth of Jesus. As I've often said: God only promised ONE Messiah, that is, *one* Savior to provide for the salvation of any and all who come to Him. Thousands of years rolled by before He was finally born, but it was God's perfect time. As the Bible says, "But when the fullness of the time had come, God sent forth His Son, born of a woman, born under the law, to redeem those who were under the law, that we might receive the adoption as sons. And because you are sons, God has sent forth the Spirit of His Son into your hearts, crying out, 'Abba, Father!' " (Gal. 4:4-6).

NOW we await the Second coming of Jesus. Like the *first* coming, we do not know just when it will happen, yet God did not leave us totally without a Guide!

Yes, TIME is in God's hands, but in another way, time is in our hands! God "has devised means" to bring "the Devil's castaways to Himself. God made HIS move, and came to us in Christ. Now, it's our move... and *our time! "Come unto Me,*" Jesus says (Mt.11:28). The Father specifies who is invited: "all you ends of the earth" (Isa.45:22). "Whosoever will may come" (Rev.22:17) means that our WILL or choice is involved. Our coming to Him is "while He may be found!" (Isa.55:6 with 2 Chron. 15:2).
