

After reviewing acknowledgments of God from all 50 state constitutions, one is faced with the prospect that maybe, just maybe, the so-called "American Civil Liberties Union" and the out-of-control federal courts are wrong!

## "Those people who will not be governed by God will be ruled by tyrants." --William Penn

In one of Jesus' story sermons He spoke of the world's rejection of Him, having them say "We will not have this man to reign over us!" (Luke 19:11-27, especially v.14). This is the same as pictured in the international attitude of rebellion against and hatred of God and His Messiah Christ, as seen in Psalm 2.

Increasingly, this world is choosing to silence God and the Bible in practical preference to atheism, materialism and humanism of all types. Nations are made up of individuals, and as an individual, you do not need to follow the crowd in the various species of paganism (though often sprinkled with occasional religious talk!). Jesus said that the "broad way leads to destruction" (Matthew 7:13), and of course He means in Hell.

Back to the beginning of this article— We repeat that humanistic, atheistic science very frequently tries to ridicule "Creationist" teaching in its attempt to destroy it. Sadly, this strategy is sometimes (dare we say, *often?*) accompanied by the wilful covering-up of known facts which undermine the arguments of those fighting so hard against the Creator God spoken of in Psalm 2 (mentioned above).

The alternative to rejecting God from our hearts, our homes, our halls of learning and halls of politics, etc., each individual, each family and each nation may put the brakes on and refuse to go on further in this Sataninspired rebellion, and turn back to God with everything they have, "lock, stock and barrel," as they said in days gone by. This is NOT an impossibility. The God that made us is also the Founder of all science, anyway.

Therefore, we may take any and every course of genuine study and bow before the Divine Originator of it is awe and worship.
