Deuteronomy, the fifth book in the Bible, is used much in the front page article. **Deuteronomy 27–28** especially refer to the Blessings and Cursings from God to Israel. The 2 chapters do not list all of God's concerns, so He spread the truth throughout the Bible to give the whole picture!

Stonehenge is unworthy to be compared to the "great stones" and the altar erected by Israel at God's command as they prepared to enter the land He had promised them long before. inward. Yet He promises that those who genuinely come to Him, He will not cast out. There is **mercy** and **blessing**!

God knows every aspect of Life perfectly. His words to Israel are His promises that call us to the greatest good, and "the fruit" of such good. Yes, His words also call us to avoid and reject the ways of evil, Now and again, newspaper articles, for God knows the "hell on earth" that Man CAN get and HAS gotten himself into.

The man WAS often at the centre of chaos, but not always! Many blame "the Jews," Israel and "Jewishcontrolled USA" for all the world's woes.

Wrong is wrong, and evil is evil, no matter who is guilty; even if it is Israel or Jewish. Yet, this article displays "a bigger picture."

Israel is and has been on centre-stage in the unfolding scenes of history. The Jews (Hebrews) have the principal role as the story plays out before our very eyes. Yet the Bible is vivid and global in application and relevance. In a way, each Bible reader is the main character. as he or she asks: "What is this saying?" and "What is this saying to ME?!"

Though Bible verses referred to or quoted in this article may relate to the people of Israel, vet the truth has personal application, to Jews and non-Jews alike... no doubt about it!

The whole human race is portrayed in the Bible with pinpoint accuracy. The Bible relates God's rescue of the human family; originally pure, but terribly and utterly "fallen" by sin. Sin links to unbelief, disobedience and deep-rooted, wilful rebellion against God. While *seeming* to be passive and innocent, sin is active, persistent, corrupt and corrupting.. Individuals and groups "air brush" it to change its appearance, add décor... "whatever..." but sin is still sin.

Jehovah God Almighty never makes terms with sin, but condemns it in Jews

and non-Jews alike. The Bible has NOT "been changed" to "make exceptions to the rules" for certain groups. No group or individual may please God now nor make it to heaven simply by their religious name tag or perceived personal goodness.

The fifth book of the Bible, written by Moses, is called **Deuteronomy**. It is a repeating of the Law which God gave to Israel...and to *us*! God is often accused of being too severe in some books in the Bible. But keep in mind that for any severity seen in the Bible, the Jews were also on the receiving end...repeatedly and severely. Yes, "they had it coming. They asked for it!" But so do we all!

There is no place on earth that God has specified the physical boundaries for like He has "The Promised Land:" a gift from God to the people of Israel. Yet, look at some of God's words to these Hebrews in Deuteronomy, for they have definite and practical application to us all.

In Deuteronomy 8, God tells the Israelites that He tested them during the 40 year "Wilderness Wanderings" before they entered the Promised Land. The tests were to show them their own hearts. He has the same loving purpose in *our* lives. God also reasoned with them (He does do that!! Isa. 1:18) so they would have no basis for thinking they got the land or all that came with it by means of their own beauty, brains or bravado. God condemns carnal pride in *them* and in us.

Chapter 9 begins with Israel's cry that the inhabitants were too big and fierce for them to go in. Many today operate by the same principle, not believing God's promise and ability to bring them into The Promised Land— that "Land" that poses difficulties and seeming impossibilities. By the way, there are two Promised Lands which are illustrated by the geographical Promised Land given by God to the Hebrews.

A Provisional driving license is a pre-requisite for a Full driving license. Similarly, God's *first* "Promised Land" for us is holiness in heart and life "in this present world" (Titus 2:12). THAT is God's pre-requisite for the "Promised Land" of Adam's race. Within every person, until

heaven. Our hope of going to heaven must be well-based. for the Bible says this about it. "And everyone who HAS this hope in *Him* [of going to heaven] *purifies himself*. just as He [i.e. God!] is pure" (1 Jn. 3:3). St. John adds, "Love has been perfected among us in this: that we may have boldness in the day of judgment; because as He is, so are we in this world" (1 Jn. 4:17).

Note God's plainly-spoken words in Deuteronomy 9 about His removing the former inhabitants from the Promised Land, so Israel could enter:

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"4 Do not think in your heart, after the LORD your God has cast them out before you, saying, 'Because of my righteousness the LORD has brought me in to possess this land'; but it is because of the wickedness of these nations that the LORD is driving them out from before you. 5 It is not because of your righteousness or the uprightness of your heart that you go in to possess their land, but because of the wickedness of these nations that the LORD your God drives them out from before you, and that He may fulfill the word which the LORD swore to your fathers, to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob. 6 Therefore understand that the LORD your God is not giving you this good land to possess because of your righteousness. for you are a stiff-necked people. 7 Remember! Do not forget how you provoked the LORD your God to wrath in the wilderness. From the day that you departed from the land of Egypt until you came to this place, you have been rebellious against the LORD. 8 Also in Horeb you provoked the LORD to wrath, so that the LORD was angry enough with you to have destroyed you.

Moses repeated in v. 24 what he said in v.7, (above) saying, "You have been rebellious against the LORD from the day that I knew you." Consider at least three things here: 1) The only reason God didn't and doesn't keep rebellious Israel out of The Promised Land is His longstanding and unchangeable promise. Though possibly hard to believe, God's promise to *them* is for the benefit of us all! 2) Though these comments describe Israel, yet they apply to every child of

on God's terms, there is an inborn and persistent disinclination and resistance to repent, turn from sin, and love, trust and obev God. People's spiritual knowledge and understanding varies, but God judges with perfect justice! 3) God's exposing of Israel's sins in these verses must not cause us to miss the wonder, splendour, mercy and the love of God shown reaching out to these very same...very *rebellious* people. There is mercy "today!" (Heb.3: 7-15).

Deuteronomy, and the whole Old Testament, as well as the NEW Testament, confirm this *original* "resident evil," as seen in the Jews, but equally applicable to non- *thefts, false witness, blasphemies*" (Matt.
