God made the universe, including this world we live in. **Our world is not in its original condition, nor are we.** The "tornado" of man's sin has caused horrific, evil destruction to God's house in which He placed us for its care. Yet, God already had *another* part to His plan. **Instead of putting** *Man* **into** *the "house" of this earth*, God planned to **put** *Himself* **into** *Man*, **and make** *Man* **His house!** No, Man does not become God, but man can become God-resident! There is a big difference. (Eph. 3:14-21).

God has His own Holy Spirit as the Chief Executive Officer (CEO), doing His utmost to see that our "house" is not spoiled in the making. Sometimes, a groom will carry his bride across the threshold of their first home. The Holy Spirit will carry us *now*, and all the way across heaven's threshold if we let Him!

Yes, Jesus is the Bridegroom. Those who are truly married to Him are both *the bride AND the house* in which God through Christ and the Holy Spirit is to live. If we eliminate the Person of the Holy Spirit, the work cannot be done (Eph. 1: 13, 14; 4: 30). If we eliminate the Biblical Christ, we eliminate God Himself, and basically bar Him from the property (Jn. 5:23; 1 Jn. 2:23). No wonder Jesus told the rejecting Jews: "YOUR house is left to you desolate!" -( Lk. 13: 35). Before, He had said "My Father's house" (Jn. 2: 16), but they wouldn't have it any other way but their own. So, Jesus backed off and basically said, "OK, YOUR house... desolate!" That same cause and effect works today; not just with the Jews; with all of us!

# THE MAGNITUDE OF MARRIAGE

One old Christian song is titled **How Great Thou Art!** It expresses the greatness of God. But, Oh, that we humans could understand how great God feels that *WE* are to *Him!* This is why **"The Golden Text of the Bible"** says *"For God so loved the world that He* gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life" (Jn. 3:16).

**Despite the vastness of the universe,** we humans are so valuable to God that the Old Testament writer couldn't comprehend it, asking *"What is man that You are mindful of him?!"* (Ps. 8: 3, 4). Those same verses are quoted in Hebrews 2: 6 and onward, and linked to Christ's death for our salvation from sin. Why? This is "a package deal," like the one that took place in the Bible's "Book of Ruth." When the crisis came, Boaz told the "first-in-the-queue" family member: "Listen, if you buy this property, you also have to marry this woman!" That primary relative backed off because of how it would effect other parts of his life that he felt were more important. This is why most people refuse to get "married" to the Lord. They refuse to let loose of "other things," and this is a killer. Jesus said so. (Mk. 4: 18, 19; Lk. 14: 26, 27, 36; with 1 Tim. 6:9).

#### **MARRIAGE HATRED**

This subtitle is from Jesus' words: "If anyone comes to Me and does not hate his father and mother, wife and children,

brothers and sisters. ves. and his own life also, he cannot be My disciple" (Lk. 14: 26, 27, 36). Some people love to find fault with this. Soon after starting work at the Gas Company in my small hometown in America many years ago, a co-worker asked me who I loved most. I immediately said "God." **Ouickly and** sharply he replied as if he was a prosecuting attorney: "What about your parents and family?!" # MARRIAGE BY SUBSTITUTE

My wife and I came to London in 1982, having been married only 3 years. June 23 will make 40 years. We didn't marry substitutes. I married *her*. She married *me*. Abraham's grandson, Jacob, was less fortunate! The trickster (Gen. 27) got tricked (Gen. 29).

God held marriage sacred throughout Bible history; *"from the beginning,"* as Jesus said (Matt. 19:8). His position still stands. Marriage is a reflection of the union between God and the people who truly love and are united to Him, through Jesus Christ (Eph. 5:25-33 with Jn. 14:6). This is the supreme reason not to *morph* marriage (that is, *change* it).

"The marriage vow," based on God's original creation of one man and one woman, makes it clear that we cannot be married and yet flirt or be unfaithful with others. The same applies with our relationship to God, for the Bible says "*if anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in Him*" (1 Jn. 2:15). The original creation not only reveals God's intention for couples, but also their inward nature of holiness. Holiness of heart and life makes union with God a possibility and a delight. The whole

# MEETING FOR MARRIAGE

"Go out to meet Him!" the call suddenly came, referring to the coming Bridegroom (Matt. 25:6). The Bible always says to be ready, not get ready. Yes, one depends on the other, but getting and keeping are different things. Many marriages confirm this fact. Many Christian conversions do, too. Please note: we must come out before we can "go out" as Matt. 25:6 said. (See 2 Cor. 6:14 to 7:1 for "come out").

"Remember Lot's wife," Jesus said (Lk. 17:32). That's the shortest Bible verse with Jesus speaking. The shortest verse in the Bible is Jesus weeping! (Jn. 11:35). "Lot" was Abraham's nephew who, with his wife and family, lived in the doomed city of Sodom. They were commanded to leave the city and not to look back. Lot's wife disobeyed, and died. Yes, "Jesus wept" is the shortest Bible verse. But from what Jesus said in Matt. 11: 23, 24, I believe that GOD may have wept for Sodom, though He had to destroy it...and London and all of Britain is following in its footsteps.

# **RIGHTEOUS REMARRIAGE**

Many of us have heard Jesus' words, "You must be born again." (Jn. 3: 7). That demand puzzled the religiouslytrained Jewish leader that Christ said it to. St. Paul added another shock by saying that we must be married again! What? "Born again?" Married again?"

The only allowance for remarriage was by the death of one of the married couple. Paul mentions this in Romans 7. He was illustrating how the Jews were "married" to the Law of Moses. Other religious people are essentially "in the same boat," including vast numbers from every branch of "professing Christianity." But we are free to be "married again!" Even unmarried nonreligious people are "married" to *something*, and are as connected to it as to their skin.

Having Christ as "The Heavenly Bridegroom" is **no** *free-for-all*; **no** *doas-you-please!* Well, in a way, I can do whatever I want. But if I love the Heavenly Bridegroom, there are things I do not want to do if I wish to please Him! Anything He does not approve of has to go.

There is only one "Bridegroom" that God provided for the *collective* "bride:" Jesus Christ. The "bride" is that body of people, *made up of individuals like us*, but who love, trust, obey and submit to Him...on *His* terms, not *our own*.

# A JEALOUS SPOUSE IN HIS JEALOUS HOUSE

As with **the word**, "**hate**," mentioned on the previous page, *some* people have a problem about **God being** "**jealous**." Marriage and relationships have been horrifically changed. Yet, many would still be grieved, if not enraged, if another would flirt with their spouse or boy/girl friend. God, in all His perfections, has a far greater right to be jealous than we humans. By the way, His jealousy is not only for His own benefit, but for *ours*!

Material things are easily destroyed. Tornadoes and hurricanes devastate huge areas with houses, possessions and people very quickly. Yet, Man wins the prize for devastation. He has worked at the job 24/7 since Eden; perfecting the art, along the way. But, though **dogs** may be **vicious**, **donkeys stubborn** and **tornadoes destructive**, they are not evil. Man is different in this essential area, despite denials of the fact of man being born with a sinful nature.
