When God made "Man," He put him in control of everything in "The Garden of Eden." The Bible-names of rivers and locations there tell us how big that "garden" was! Kew **Gardens** is nothing in comparison. There in Eden. Adam and Eve had **SOMETHING TO DO.**

God gave Man more to do than tending to the breath-taking Garden of Eden. By the way, Eden didn't have one speck of pollution! On top of that, imagine regular visits from God who had created it all and put it World-wide, people's lives are under their perfectly competent care.

God's "qualifications" far exceed three areas listed above... and more, the excellence and achievements of all of history's greatest individuals put together. What a Regular Visitor!

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REVERSE QUARANTINE: The first "lockdown" was in the Garden of Eden. Man was locked OUT, not IN, his Garden home. Adam and Eve had already abandoned their true and original "Home:" God! Augustine well said that man is not at rest until he finds his rest in God. A wise woman in the Bible said "God has made a Way to bring His evicted back Home!" (2 Sam. 14:14). God doesn't want us expelled from Him, so He made a WAY to bring us Home; that WAY is Jesus Christ. Come Home, then lock yourself IN! IT IS ESSENTIAL!

Not even angels can comprehend the love of God toward Man. Yet, Eden's "regular Visitor" took... and He still takes... personal interest in us! God gave Man SOMETHING TO DO. But in that true story, God also gave Man SOMEONE TO LOVE. Adam and Eve chose to DO and to LOVE the wrong thing.

Let's "fast-forward" to 2021. The Bible uses various ideas, illustrations and examples to help us to understand. For example, it pictures our life and walk with God as if we were a farmer, a soldier, an investor, an Olympic athlete, a house and even a garden! There we are, back to a garden!

If we are "God's garden," and He puts us in charge of it to care for it, then each of us are "in the same boat" as our "first parents," Adam and Eve. You may not like cultivating a garden. Perhaps you prefer cultivating your mind with interesting and useful research. That's a type of gardening. The greatest "garden" is the garden of our hearts and minds, spiritually. Samuel Chadwick prayed, "O Lord, make us intensely spiritual, but keep us perfectly natural and thoroughly practical."

Sleeping can be good or bad. In the Garden of Eden, God made Adam sleep VERY deeply when He created Eve. What an amazing creation! But something happened.

Temptation visited Eve in Eden. Temptation is not sin; *yielding to it* is. Eve yielded, and so sinned. Sin ruined *her*, and then *Adam*. Eve slept *spiritually* and lost "her first husband," for Adam was not the same man anymore. Eve changed, too.

Adam and Eve lost Eden, their physical home, by "falling asleep" in the garden. But they also lost their greatest "Home:" God. They didn't feel "at home" with God anymore, so they hid when they heard Him coming. It messed up the whole world; not just human beings. (Rom. 8:22; Jer. 12:11).

Here is a prayer from the Bible: "Look attentively and answer me, O Jehovah my God! Lighten my eyes so that I do not sleep the sleep of death." (Psalm 13:3).

Adam and Eve fell asleep on the job, and humanity has been asleep ever since. God is trying to wake us up, calling out like this...

* "Awake, you who sleep, arise from the dead, and Christ will give you light." (Eph. 5: 14) * "And do this, knowing the time, that now it is high time to awake out of sleep" (Rom. 13:11)

* "Awake to righteousness, and do not sin; for some do not have the knowledge of God. I speak this to your shame." (1Cor 15:34)

* "Therefore let us not sleep, as others do, but let us watch and be sober." (1Thess. 5:6)

Here is a true-life account in the life of St. Peter. He was not asleep spiritually, but he was asleep in prison. He wasn't in a garden, but was sleeping between two soldiers that were "guard'n" him! The local authorities were trying to stop Peter from telling people about salvation through Christ. Suddenly, swiftly and silently something happened!

"Now behold, an angel of the Lord stood by him, and a light shone in the prison; and he struck <u>Peter</u> on the side and raised him up, saying, 'Arise quickly!' And his chains fell off his hands." (Acts 12:7)

It was a God-ordered jailbreak!

Charles Wesley wrote 6,000 hymns (church songs). Earlier in his life, Wesley knew the Bible, but he didn't know God. He and his brother, **John**, had gone to America in the failed plan "to convert the heathen." John later wrote: "but who shall convert me?" At that point, those brothers were like the person in the Bible who said, "They made me the keeper of the vine gardens, but my

own vine **garden** I have not kept."-(Song of Sol. 1:6). What of us?

Immediately after Charles Wesley experienced "The New Birth" (Jn. 3:3; 2 Cor. 5:17) on **21 May, 1738 near London's Aldersgate Street,** he wrote a hymn to commemorate the great event. John's conversion was three days later; also at Aldersgate Street. Charles used <u>St. Peter's miraculous release from prison to illustrate his own release from "the prison-house of sin," writing...</u>

Long my imprisoned spirit lay Fast bound in sin and nature's night; Thine eye diffused a quick'ning ray, I woke, the dungeon flamed with light; My chains fell off, my heart was free; I rose, went forth and followed Thee.

(Definitions from song, above:)
"Fast bound:" tightly tied up or fastened.
"diffused:" to spread over a wide area.
"quickening:" life-giving; reviving.
"Thine" and "Thee:" Your. (Old English words referring here to God.)

Jesus told a story of a farmer who planted good seeds in his **garden**. (Matt.13:24-30). "While men slept," an enemy planted bad seeds; making that man's gardening work harder than ever. The world is in trouble. While people have been "sleeping," the Devil has been busy planting bad seeds. Trouble comes at harvest time.

Solomon spoke of such sleeping twice (Prov. 24:30-34; 6:6-11); both times illustrating disaster. The world is a garden. Man is a garden. Both are in disaster, for people are asleep in the garden. God has given us **SOMETHING TO DO.** God help us to do it...*HIS* way!

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
