quenched,” (9:48) which is quoted from Isaiah 66:24.

So, Clapton’s 1967 reference to a **Strange Brew** that is “killin what’s inside of you” can well apply to the physical damage being done by the jabs, as his new song says.

Yet, even the jab and its damage cannot take our soul as Clapton’s new song says (not that he meant that, literally). His new vax-alarm song says, “If you wanna claim my soul you’ll have to come and break down this door.” **Note two things** about that line from Clapton’s song:

1) Three persons have greatest control of a person’s “soul”: **God**, who made it, **Satan** who hijacked it, and **ourselves**, for **WE** decide if our soul stays in the hands of God or the Devil. It is said: “God casts a vote for us. The Devil casts a vote against us. But we cast the deciding vote.” And Jesus said “No man can serve two masters.” (Matt. 6:24; Lk. 16:13). It’s time to chose.

2) **NO ONE**, earthly or spiritual, can “claim my soul” if I stay behind the “door,” for the door of the child of God is Jesus Christ! He said so! “I am the Door!” (John 10: 7, 9).

So, how does a person get behind that Door? The last words in red print at the bottom of page 1 say “Thoroughly repent and be saved.” The four-point message in **the little box** near the bottom of page 2 tells more about it. Those four facts are a brief summary of the message of Britain’s powerful 18th century Evangelical Revival.

That little box tells about being “saved.” The steps to being “saved” are brief and simple. In Jesus’ first preaching, He said “the kingdom of God is at hand. Repent, and believe in the Good News” [of salvation]. (Mark 1: 14, 15). See two parts in Christ’s message: *repent* and *believe*.

Bible repentance is specific and radically thorough; no games. The Bible tells the difference between shallow, false “believing in Jesus” and the genuine. “The sorrow of the world [mere regret] brings death” (not just physical death) but “godly sorrow brings repentance to salvation.” (See 2 Cor. 7:10, 11; Matt.3: 1-12; Lk.3: 1-9; Rev. 2: 1-5, 16, 21, 22; 3:3, 15-20). ■

This true story sounds like 2021. To win as those men won, it will take a positive *and* a negative. Not bowing to the mandate is the negative. Openly declaring faithfulness to worship the only true God is the positive. It is the *supreme* positive for *any* of us.

STRANGE BREW, INDEED

The three "witches" perfectly fit my focus here. Their "**brew**" is likely not for themselves, but to give to others; something deadly... something evil.

In 1967, British rock band, **Cream**, came out with a song titled **Strange Brew**. One repeated line was "*killin' what's inside of you.*" What is being forced on society today is doing that very thing: "*killin' what's inside of you.*"

One stanza says "*some kind of demon messin' in the flue. If you don't watch out it'll stick to you, To you. What kind of fool are you?*"

Cream guitarist, Eric Clapton, who helped to write **Strange Brew**, recently produced the song, **This Has Gotta Stop**. I call his new song **Strange Brew 2021**; now 54 years after that original one.

Clapton has received criticism for his new song which sounds an alarm against the "**Strange Brew**"

possibly inside the Covid jabs. Eric Clapton has my sympathy on this.

The 1967 **Strange Brew** lyrics refer to demonic activity which is "*messin' in the flue.*" A "flue" is a chimney, a duct, a tube, a pipe... or how about our blood system?! The present evil crisis that Clapton's new song is about involves demon-pushed "*messin*" in our whole body.

The 1967 song says that "*If you don't watch out it'll stick to you.*" The developing side-effects of what Clapton's new song is about are long-term; possibly even life-long. However, the jab effects have, too frequently, struck with immediate and debilitating power; even death. No wonder **Strange Brew** asked "*What kind of fool are you?*"

Is this a pre-planned pandemic to "decrease the surplus population," to use Mr. Scrooge's words? Perhaps there are even more goals. Yet, even if this is so, there is something far more serious for us to consider; Jesus said so.

Jesus said "*And do not fear those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul. But rather fear Him who is able to destroy both soul and body in hell.*" (Matthew 10:28). Luke adds "*yes, I say to you, fear Him!*" (12:5). This "*destroying*" is not annihilation... extinction... nor *total* destruction, for Mark, referring to hell, adds "*where their worm does not die, and the fire is not*"

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
