Kosher police" or the Roman Government? Whatever the reason, it was a big mistake. Many today are doing the same.





Joining the "Star" of God's Word and His Spirit are godly travellers, past and present, who help to encourage and guide, so keep sailing! (Hebrews 1:1-3 with Ecclesiastes 4:12).

THE VERY FIRST CHRISTMAS WAS...

THE GREATEST PHILANTHROPY FOR THE GREATEST POVERTY AMID THE GREATEST INSANITY

"<u>Philanthropy</u>" (above) refers to charity, compassion and generosity. (AN EARLY START!) No one has ever done earlier "Christmas shopping" than God. His Christmas Gift to us was "from before the foundation of the world!" (1 Peter 1:20; Revelation 13:8). That's early!

All three "*GREATESTS*," (see above), are in St. John 3:16, "<u>The Golden Text of the Bible</u>," which also presents the Bible's Main Actors and Actions in one Peerless and Priceless Proclamation! It says, "For God <u>so loved</u> the world that He gave His one and only Son, that whosoever believes on Him should not perish, but have everlasting life." (Jn. 3:16)

"MADLY IN LOVE!" God demonstrated this kind of "INSANITY" in that First Christmas. But *there*. God didn't "Lose His Marbles;" He Loosed His Marvels—scene after scene!! And what "actors!" John the Baptist's old parents! Mary! Joseph! The Bethlehem Shepherds! That old man, Simeon, and the old woman...and finally, the Wise Men from the East! In ALL of these moving scenes, we see the love of God Almighty. He was, "INSANELY IN LOVE" with us all! He is the same today.

"MAD" has negative meaning, too, and was *also* at work in the first Christmas. Today it is going "big time!" King Herod tried to have "the little Lord Jesus" killed. Herod represents the INSANITY of Christmas from the evil and antagonistic side, and "Herod" is very active today...but, so is God! In the Christmas story, Herod's INSANITY...his madness and



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Christ came to remove our **GREATEST POVERTY** (see page 2) by bringing Heaven's Best to us... *"the pearl of great price," "the treasure hid in the field" etc.* (Matthew 13 "Parables of the Kingdom"). **What a feast!**

Feasts need many ingredients. I have already blended Christmas and the Cross. Now, let's add the Resurrection and Ascension which perfectly and properly fit into God's own "recipe!"

The Cross was not a victory for those who crucified Jesus Christ. By the Cross, Jesus "stripped, disarmed and rid Himself of all the hostile powers of evil. He, then made them a public example, exposing them to public shame; displaying His triumph over them by way of that Cross!" (multiversions of Colossians 2:13-15). The Lord Jesus Christ came, as foretold, to provide God's cure for **THE WORLD'S GREATEST POVERTY** by going to the Cross!

Christmas is associated with **GIFT-giving** due to **God's Great GIFT** in Christ...but there's more!

Jesus Christ poured out GIFTS when He JOYFULLY poured out Himself on the Cross! "...Who for the JOY set before Him, endured the cross."-(Hebrews 12:2, Luke 2:10).

After Christ's Cross was His Resurrection and Ascension. The Ascension highlighted GIFT GIVING, too! Read it: "When He ascended on high, He led captivity captive, and GAVE GIFTS to men." (Ephesians 4: 7, 8).

Those verses quote Psalm 68:18 that refers to **GIFTS** given and/or received in connection to the Lord and "the rebellious..." just like in Psalm 2, where God holds out the offer of peace... even to conspiring rebels!! The world is filled with rebels in every corner and at every level, and all rebels should take notice of this.

Psalm 68, above, also says that God "*daily loads us with benefits*, *even the God of our salvation*!", (verse 19). WOW! <u>MORE GIFTS</u>!

As we sail further into the ocean of a **New Year**, The Christ of Christmas and the Cross knows our exact location *without a sextant* as mentioned on page 1. Christ Himself, put all the stars in place! He knows the stars by name...and He knows *our* name. **New Year 2024** stretches out ahead of us. *God's hand* stretches out toward us! Take it. Trust it.

Happy New Year! Happy Valentine's Day! Happy Easter ! and Thank God for the Cross!

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1:21). <u>*THIS*</u> is "holiness "without which no one shall see the Lord." (Hebrews 12:14).

Another English church-song of the 1700s says: "Be of sin <u>the</u> <u>double cure</u>, <u>Save from wrath</u> and <u>make me pure</u>." When God saves us from sin, He saves us from "the wrath to come", (Matthew 3:7). That's "<u>step one</u>" of "<u>the double cure</u>."

"Pentecost," (also called "Whitsunday") is on Sunday, 19 May this year. It refers to "the promise of the Father;" the coming of God's Holy Spirit to "<u>make me</u> <u>pure</u>." (Luke 24:49). That's "<u>step</u> two" of "the double cure." Then keep obeying! (Acts 5:32).

Jesus is God's Promised <u>Gift</u> of "Christmas." The Holy Spirit, "*The promise of the Father*" is His Promised <u>Gift</u> of Pentecost! But Christ HAD to come first!

Jesus made a <u>wilful choice</u>, but opposite from Adam's <u>wilful</u> <u>choice</u>! Yes, **JESUS KNEW** the consequences, but also knew the wonderful resulting "Possibilities of Grace" for you and me. What love! One song says of Jesus:

"He left the splendour of heaven, <u>KNOWING</u> His destiny. Was the lonely hill of Golgotha* There to lay down His life for me.

If that isn't love!!"

(*Golgotha, just mentioned, is where Jesus was crucified.)

Christmas was for the Cross. Christ's willing sacrifice on the Cross provided what Old Testament sacrifices could never do:

"For it is not possible that the blood of bulls and goats could take away sins. Therefore, <u>when</u> <u>He came into the world, He said</u>: 'Sacrifice and offering You did

not desire, <u>but a body You have</u> <u>prepared for Me</u>. In burnt offerings and sacrifices for sin You had no pleasure.' Then I said, 'Behold, I have come--In the volume of the book it is written of Me--<u>To do Your will</u>, O God.'" (Heb. 10: 5-7; quotes Psalm 40).

So, in the verses just quoted, God promised a Saviour who would die for our sins to provide "The Way" (John 14:6) for us to get back to God. Ok, 1+1= 2. So, think: 1) <u>That promised Sacrifice</u> must die. 2) You cannot "kill" <u>steam or gas or a ghost</u>! It took "a body," just like that verse, above, says. That "body" arrived as the Baby Born in Bethlehem.

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murder...focused around little Bethlehem. Today's "Herod" is *globally* active, seemingly trying to correct for past failure and complete the job, once and for all. He will fail again.



I'm glad THE WISE MEN listened to the *TRUE* "Main Stream Media" (God!) instead of Herod's "Monarch Misleading and Mandating Media!" (See Matthew 2) Let's do the same!

Psalm 2, written over 1000 years before The First Christmas, tells of the global uniting of people "against the Lord and against His Christ." First of all, rebel planners... individually or collectively... are no match for God. Secondly, "against His Christ" means the planners put a sort of "Mafia contract" out on "Christmas." They failed. But all such rebels, whether "peaceful" or noisy, have obviously not learned their lesson, for this **INSANITY** is going on today! God laughs at such global insurrection! (Psalm 2: 4).

But God doesn't wickedly "laugh" at people. In the First Christmas, God wasn't laughing when Herod had all those little children slaughtered in his INSANITY-driven attempt to get rid of this promised Messiah-Saviour, Christ. God doesn't laugh at this world's present tragedies, either, and that includes TODAY'S purposely-slaughtered children, world-wide!...and it <u>IS</u> happening! In Psalm 2, God LAUGHS...

but also LOVES! Mark that down!! Those global conspirators had specifically declared their target: "against the Lord and against His Christ." Yet, even to these rebels, God offers peace... yes, on HIS terms. That same offer is available today.

In The First Christmas, Jesus was laid in a Cattle "Cradle." At age 33. He was shamelessly and ruthlessly judged, beaten, mocked and then put on Calvary's Cross outside Jerusalem's city gates. (John 19: 17, 18; Hebrews 13:12). We will especially remember this on 29 March, this year. On the Cross, Jesus prayed "Father, forgive them for they don't know what they are doing." INSANITY of the worst sort! Sin always is. Rebel planners... as in Psalm 2... as at the Cross... and as today... have no idea of the full consequences of

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their choices **INSANITY** indeed!

Such rebel planners have an **INSANITY** that is mental. moral. maliciously spiritual... and will be eternal, unless rebels experience a God-enabled change "while it is called today!" (Hebrews 3:7-15).

Psalm 2 tells of a *foolish* and failed coup d'état against THE **GOVERNMENT** OF GOD. Yes, God has **GOVERNMENT**! Between 500-600 years before Christ was born. God had the prophet. Isaiah, write about His GOVERNMENT and to gently place that GOVERNMENT in Bethlehem's manger! Here is what God had Isaiah to write:

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"For unto us a Child is born, unto us a Son is given; and the **GOVERNMENT** will be upon His shoulder. And His name will be called Wonderful, Counsellor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. Of the increase of HIS GOVERNMENT and peace there will be no end, upon

the throne of David and over His kingdom, to order it and establish it with judgment and justice from that time forward, even forever. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will perform this." (Isaiah 9: 6, 7).

Did vou see that Tiny Tot's **Titles?!** Also notice that GOD'S **GOVERNMENT** links to peace... true peace (see page 8 box)...and to order, righteousness and justice.

Furthermore, God had Micah the prophet to tell where that Baby, God-King was to be born; in Bethlehem! (Micah 5:2). The back page article tells how religious leaders knew exactly what Micah had said, and that they told this to King Herod.

The Greatest Poverty (page 2) started in the Garden of Eden when, by sin, Adam and Eve were "stripped" — spiritually, morally, mentally and other ways that are essential to our total well-being. Instead of "from rags to riches," they went the opposite way like no other people in history! The Christ of Christmas and the Cross is God's cure for that human loss Revelation 3: 14-22 (note verse 20) is God's love-filled invitation to "sin-stripped" people today.

When Adam, Eve and, as the tragic result, ALL humanity were "stripped" in Eden, the instantly created effect then began filling everything with all the spreading branches of sin that have been defiling and destroying the whole world...people AND planet. YES, **THE GREATEST POVERTY!**





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Jesus is called the "Second Adam," the "Desire of nations" and "the woman's conqu'ring Seed" in Charles Wesley's 1739 hymn, "Hark! The Herald Angels Sing." In this hymn, just below, England's Wesley prays for us to be reinstated in God's love:

"Come, Desire of nations, come, Fix in us Your humble home: Rise, the woman's conqu'ring Seed, Bruise in us the serpent's head Adam's likeness, now efface, Stamp Your image in its place: Second Adam from above. Reinstate us in Your love."

The reference, above, to "the woman's conquering Seed" and of "bruising the serpent's head" is in the Bible. (Genesis 3:15). Adam's sin was greatly caused by the lying deception of Satan, "the serpent," whose head God said would be bruised/crushed by "the woman's conquering seed" which But Jesus didn't even stop there! was Christ. It WAS crushed on His Cross, by His Resurrection, and further crushed in His Ascension!

Even with his amazing advantages Adam sinned, bringing "hell on earth" and hell in the human heart. Sin still does.

sin. God gave Adam and Eve the promise of the Messiah-Saviour. Yes. Jesus Christ is God's Bridge of Hope for us all... and "we are not following cleverly made-up fairv tales!" (2 Peter 1:16).

Wesley's hymn-song refers to Jesus as "Second Adam from above." In temptation, Adam fell into sin. Jesus, the Second Adam, came, was also tempted by Satan, had no more help than Adam had, but had a far different outcome! Jesus kept totally and constantly committed to "the Father." Adam was created with sinless holiness and amazing intellect, but that was not enough! It must be maintained.

The faithful, loving attitude of Christ to the Father was told before in the words, "I delight to do Your will, O God." (Psalm 40: 7, 8). Jesus confirmed that commitment. saying "He Who sent Me is with Me. The Father has not left Me alone for I always do those things that please Him." (John 8: 29).

Jesus was God's "Christmas **Present**" Who purchased salvation for all, but we must come to Him: many refuse (John 5:40). Jesus said that we can live "just as" HE did "that the world may believe". (John 17). He came, as the angel Yet, even in the face of their Gabriel said, to save us from all sin and keep us saved. (Matthew (continued on page 6)

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
